WHAT IS BIODIVERSITY? Biodiversity represents all the world's living organisms. Information in their cells dictate why they look, taste, smell and act differently. This diversity is the biological wealth upon which all life depends.



HOW MANY SPECIES ARE THERE?

There are an estimated 250,000 different flowering plants in the world, giving rise to most of our foods. There are also nonflowering plants, like ferns and mosses. Many plant species are endangered, but banks" have been created to keep seeds from these species.

WHERE DID THE DIFFERENT **SPECIES ORIGINATE?**

Different crop species originated in different regions of the world. Those varied sites usually have a wide diversity of species resources important to preserve for future food security.
